Watch a video online of animals in their natural habitat

Learning link: Three Billy Goats Gruff, Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear, Goldilocks and the Three Bears

Observe the animals that come into your garden / environment.

Learning link: Owl and the Pussycat

Have a teddy bears picnic.

Learning link: sorting objects, sharing, language development.

Choose a story to read with a member of your family.

Learning link: Enjoy listening to longer stories.

Help an adult to bake something delicious.

Learning link: observing changes.

Make a picture of the night sky.

Learning link: Fine motor skills, giving meaning to a mark.

Go on a hunt for simple patterns. E.g. red, blue, red, blue / apple, orange, apple, orange.

Learning link: Identify and describe patterns

Get your clothes ready for school. Can you tell an adult the items that you need?

Learning link: Communication and language, sorting.

Find a ball and create a bowling game.

Learning link: Gross motor skills

These home learning opportunities are to enable your child to build on skills that they are developing in school in a different environment.
